

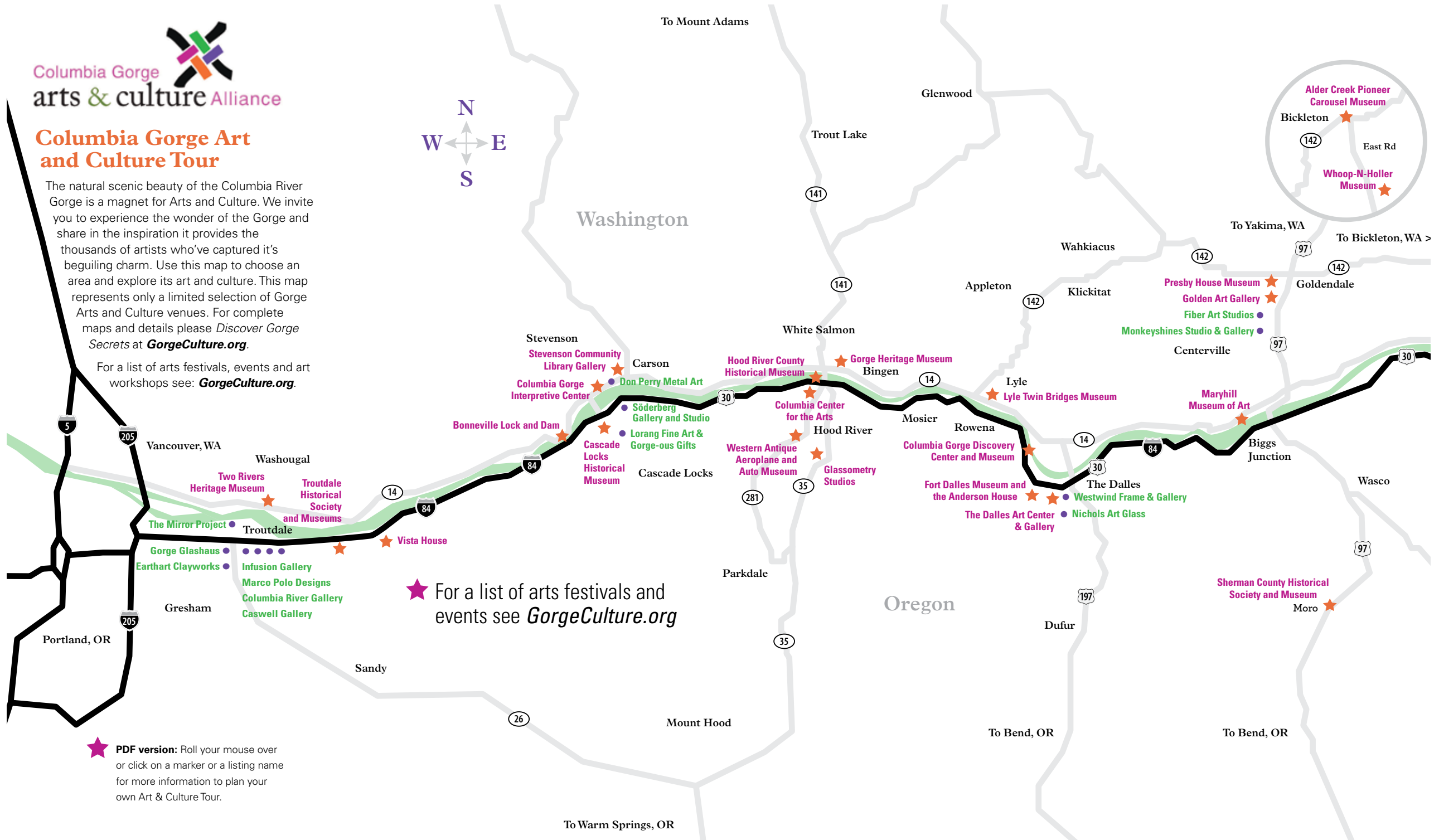
Columbia Gorge Art and Culture Tour

THE ALDER CREEK PIONEER CAROUSEL MUSEUM (509) 896-2007

One of the oldest carousels on the West Coast, the carousel, purchased from Portland's Oaks Park in 1929, is originally built by the Herschell-Spillman Company of North Tonawanda, NY.
